## Project Overview

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Construction of drill site leases and road network upgrade at Santos Mereenie Oil & Gas Fields.

In an unprecedented decision, Intract secured the civil works package for the \$100 million Mereenie Oil and Gas Fields project.

A team of nine, along with four local Aboriginal men also employed by Intract, mobilised to the remote site located in the Amadeus Basin, approximately 300 kilometres south-west of Alice Springs. Intract was contracted to construct eight lease pads for new drill rigs and upgrade approximately 40 kilometres of roads for better access to the site.

For Santos, the project was not just about capital and energy growth, it was also about giving Aboriginal people a stake hold in the investment and improving Indigenous communities.
